**MOTION FOR TRANSPORTATION EXPENSES TO
ENABLE DEFENDANT TO APPEAR FOR TRIAL IN
UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE COURT**

The Defendant, Lakeysha Miles, by her attorneys, James Wyda, Federal Public Defender for the District of Maryland, and Carrie Howie Corcoran, Assistant Federal Public Defender, moves this Honorable Court for an Order, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. Section 4285, directing the United States Marshals Service to pay for the transportation costs associated with travel from her home in Ft.
